Please read this End User License Agreement (EULA) carefully. By downloading or installing Fantasia Type's Font Software you agree to the terms of this License Agreement.

Usage rights	By purchasing the Font Software Fantasia Type grants you a non-exclusive license. This license allows you to install and use the fonts on a limited number of computers within your organization, equal to the number of users specified in your order receipt.
Modifications	<p>You are not allowed to change, reproduce, sell, rent, sublicense, transfer, modify, adapt, convert, translate, reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble, alter or create derivative works of the Font Software in any way. For example: You are not allowed to add or modify glyphs or convert the font file into another file or webfont file by yourself.</p> <p>You are not allowed to change or hire somebody to change the purchased Font Software.)
