



Fred's Fonts End User License Agreement

This legal Agreement between a licensee ("You") and Fred Wiltshire, Fred's Fonts ("The Designer"). By downloading and/or installing, copying, or using the Font Software, you agree the terms of this Agreement. If You do not agree to these terms, do not purchase this License, or download, or install, or use the Font Software.

1. Permitted Use

The purchased license grants You the non-exclusive right to use the Font Software. The amount of purchased licenses required is determined by the License Options section. You may use the Font Software for creating any printed or digital documents, images and goods, brand identities, logotypes. Use of the Font Software is not limited geographically. If the planned use is not included in the License Options section, or if you are not sure whether the planned use is permitted, please contact the Designer.

2. Restrictions

You are not permitted to modify, convert, reverse engineer, decompile, rent, lease, publish or distribute in any way the Font Software as a whole or in parts. You may alter the typeface outlines for logotypes or any other design purposes. Such modifications may not be inserted into the Font Software, its copies or used in any digital font file formats. For any customisations of the Font Software please contact the Designer. Unauthorised modifications by any third parties are not permitted. Typeface software and its constituent parts (glyphs, metrics and source code) may not be renamed, modified or altered in anyway by the licensee. The licensee may not share, sell, lease or distribute typeface software.

3. Font Software Sold

This Font Software is a work in progress and is sold as is. Licensee acknowledges that there may be bugs and/or flaws in the Font Software. The Designer will attempt to communicate the current state of any Font Software at the time of sale, but is not required to fix or address any bugs or flaws in the Font Software. The Designer makes no warranties, express or implied, and disclaims all implied warranties, including any warranty of merchantability or warranty of fitness for a particular purpose.

4. Individual User License

The purchase of 1 Font Software license grants up to 3 users, of a single organization, the right to use a copy of the Font Software. 2 copies may be made for archival purposes only. Back-up copies must be kept secure and third party access is not allowed.

5. Multiple User Licences

If more than 3 users will be using the font software, you are required to purchase a multi-users license using the following table as a reference. If more user licenses are needed, please get in touch at:

6. Typesetting Products

You may not use the Font to create alphabet or letterform products for resale where the product consists of individual letterforms, including rubber stamps, die-cut products, stencil products, or adhesive sticker alphabet products where the likeness of the Font can be reproduced and the end-user of said products can create their own typesetting. An extended license to produce these may be available for an additional fee.

7. Web use.

The licensee is limited to the uploading of typeface software to their organisations servers, websites (domains and sub domains owned by the licensee) and the total number of unique visitors as stated in the order summary. Clients or third parties do not constitute a part of the licensee's organisation and typeface software may not be used by a third party organisation. Typeface software intended for web use (.woff) may not be used as a desktop font or converted to any other format.

8. Icons, Dingbats and Patterns in Products

You may not use illustrations or images in the Font other than letterforms, numbers, punctuation marks, diacritics, etc., in a manner where the illustration or image becomes the primary aspect of a product for resale. For example, a dingbat image in the font cannot be the sole design element on a coffee cup, t-shirt, greeting card, etc., intended for resale, unless an extended license is acquired at an (affordable) additional fee.

9. Other Use

This EULA grants You the rights for Desktop Use and Web use. For any other uses such as App, Games, Softwares, ePublications, You must contact Fred Wiltshire to enquire the option of acquiring appropriate extended license(s). This license expressly prohibits the embedding, inclusion, calling or linking of the Font Software within hardware and software in any form whatsoever. This includes, but is not limited to, video games, server-side applications, online document creation, mobile apps, kiosks, and oem products or software.

10. Embedding

Embedding of the Font Software into documents or internet pages is permitted using any technique, including @fontface, under the following conditions: You must use the web fonts provided in your package. Linking to the full OpenType or TrueType fonts designed for desktop

installation is not permitted. The web fonts may only be installed on website domains that are under the direct control of the Licensee.

11. Demo Fonts

You may use the Demo version of the Font Software for testing, student works, non-commercial and non-profit projects, as long as it doesn't violate the Restrictions section above. Design of a personal portfolio itself (website/digital/printed) or a personal brand identity is considered to be a commercial project. However, You may include projects that feature the Demo fonts in their portfolio

12. EULA Updates

The Designer may update or modify this EULA at any time. Your use of the Font Software following any update or modification constitutes Your agreement to follow and be bound by the EULA as updated or modified. The updates or modifications will not be retroactive, and the most current version of the Terms that You have agreed to will govern. You are fully responsible for accessing EULA updates via Future Fonts and adhering to new license terms.

13. Intellectual property.

All rights, titles and interest to the typeface software including copyright is retained by The Designer. This agreement does not give You the copyright to the design of the Font Software, but the rights to use the fonts.

14. Termination

This license will automatically terminate if You fail to comply with any term of this Agreement.

15. Governing Law

This EULA takes effect when You download or use the font and is governed by the laws of England and the courts of England shall have the exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with it or its subject matter, including non-contractual disputes. This EULA constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the Font Software and supersedes all prior understanding, whether written or oral. Except as provided in this agreement, no term or condition of this agreement may be amended or deemed waived, except by a writing signed by the parties that refers to this agreement. If any term or part of a term of this agreement is invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the rest of the agreement will remain in effect.
